# What's Next for Cardinal Parents?



## Congratulations on your Cardinal's acceptance to UIW!

1. Visit the Office of Financial Assistance.

Meet with our financial aid staff to discuss your Cardinal's financial award and available options. Develop a financial plan to prepare for any out of pockets costs.

2. Make sure your Cardinal has access to the Cardinal Apps portal.

With their Cardinal Apps account, students can check their schedule, UIW email, balances and more. Make sure your Cardinal has access to their UIW email, as this is the official communication portal at UIW.

3. Submit proof of bacterial meningitis vaccination.

Texas state law mandates that all students under the age of 22 entering a Texas college or university provide proof of vaccination against bacterial meningitis during the five years preceding admission to the University. Your Cardinal may submit their vaccination record in PDF form to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@uiwtx.edu.

4. Apply for On-Campus Housing.

Is your Cardinal interested in living on campus? Visit uiw.edu/housing for information.

5. Submit final documents.

Students must submit the following documents to the Office of Admissions:

- Final official high school transcript (including final GPA and graduation date).
- Official college transcript (for students who took dual credit courses).
- Official AP, ACT, SAT, or IB test scores, if applicable.
- 6. Complete Business Office Items.

Apply for a parking permit through Cardinal Cars in the Cardinal Apps portal. Upon receiving your Cardinal's class schedule, set up a payment plan, if needed. More information can be found at bit.ly/UIWpayplan. If your Cardinal is already insured, waive the UIW insurance at bit.ly/uiw-waivers.

7. Contact Student Disability Services.

Students needing accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 can apply for support services. To qualify for services, the student must provide the Office of Student Disability Services with the appropriate documentation of their disability at the time services and/or accommodations are requested.
