
AY: Placement Fall 2024



Dear Student,

Welcome to the University of the Incarnate Word. The math faculty is excited to help you get started on your college math track. According to our records, you will be required to take MATH 0320: Core Math Prep. This is a 3-hour, zero-credit course meant to prepare you for college-level mathematics. However, we would like to offer a FREE opportunity to fulfill this requirement before fall classes begin through ALEKS PPL.

**BEFORE** you can take your core mathematics class (MATH 1304, 1306, or 2303), you are required to complete the UIW Mathematics Placement through ALEKS Placement, Preparation and Learning (PPL). If your major allows you to take MATH 1308: Foundations of Practical Mathematics as a core math credit, you will **not** need to participate as there are no prerequisites for placement in MATH 1308.

Success in college begins with appropriate course placement. ALEKS PPL uses a specialized adaptive assessment to create a personalized learning module that lets you refresh your math knowledge. This allows you to be placed in the right course, expediting your path to a degree. You will even be able to work beyond your initial ALEKS placement to advance even further into the UIW math offerings. The last day your ALEKS PPL score will count for math placement will be Aug. 9, 2024, at 11:59 pm CDT.

## **General Information About the Remote Assessment**

- 1. No outside assistance is permitted. This includes getting help from others and using outside materials. Other individuals should not be in the room while you take the test.
- 2. Your computer's webcam and the lockdown browser will be used as your personal proctor. The webcam lens must not be covered up or otherwise obscured. Your face should be on camera at all times.
  - a. If your webcam is built into your computer, avoid adjusting the screen after the exam starts. A common mistake is to push the screen back, which can cut off part of your face during recording.
  - b. Don't lie down on a couch or bed during the exam. There is a greater chance you'll move out of the video frame or change your position relative to the webcam.
  - c. Don't take the exam in a dark room. If the details of your face don't show clearly during the webcam check, the automated video analysis is more likely to flag you as missing.

- d. Avoid backlighting situations, such as sitting with your back to a window. As a general rule, sit with light in front of your face, not behind your head.
- e. Select a distraction-free environment for the exam. Televisions and other people in the room can draw your attention away from the screen. Other people who come into view of the webcam may cause the automated system to flag your exam.
- 3. No outside calculators are permitted. A calculator icon will appear on the screen when it is allowed to be used. You can use blank paper and a pen/pencil to work out problems, however. No use of cell phones or other electronic devices is permitted.

The University of the Incarnate Word takes academic integrity very seriously and investigates all allegations of academic dishonesty. If you are found to be in violation of the academic integrity policy, you run the risk of having your test score invalidated.

#### **About the ALEKS PPL Math Placement Assessment**

ALEKS PPL is an online, adaptive system that covers a broad spectrum of mathematics topics. The length of the Placement Assessment will vary but it can include up to 30 questions. You will see some, but not all, of the math you learned in high school. It is a Placement Assessment, not a preview of math courses at the University of the Incarnate Word. It is designed to identify if you are prepared for a particular course. After you take your first Placement Assessment, you will have the opportunity to review and master additional topics to reassess and improve your placement.

- The assessment may contain up to 30 questions. It normally takes 60-90 minutes, but you have up to 2.5 hours to complete it. You cannot save and come back to the test: You must complete it in one sitting.
- The problems must be done in order. Once you have answered a question, you cannot go back and change it.


If you have questions about your Placement Assessment scores and the courses you should take for your degree program, contact your academic advisor in your major.

## **Steps To Begin ALEKS PPL**




ALEKS will begin with a brief tutorial to make sure you are comfortable with the math palette tools before your Placement Assessment begins. The tutorial shows you how to enter different types of answers, how to use the ALEKS calculator, and how to graph. If you aren't sure how to input an answer, or need help while you are taking the ALEKS Placement Assessment, select the **Help** button below the answer pallet tools. Going to the tutorial during your Placement Assessment will **NOT** impact your Placement Assessment results.

# After Your Assessment: What class does this put me in?

After completing the Placement Assessment, you will see your score. You will then be able to see what class you placed into, view cut score information, and the number of times that the Placement Assessment can be retaken.

ALEKS Score	Math Placement
ALEKS PPL 0 - 45	MATH 0320 (Core Math Prep) This course does not count toward degree requirements.  Or  MATH 1308 (Foundations of Practical Mathematics)* *Refer to your degree requirements to determine if this class is an option.
ALEKS PPL score of 46 - 60	Placed into either ** MATH 1304 (College Algebra), MATH 2303 (Intro to Probability and Statistics), or MATH 1306 (College Geometry)  ** Course dependent upon degree plan requirements.
ALEKS PPL score of 61 - 75	MATH 1311 (Pre-Calculus)
ALEKS PPL score of 76 - 100	MATH 2312 (Calculus I) or appropriate math course required by degree program.

## **Retaking the Math Placement Assessment**

You will need 3 hours of learning modules and 48 hours of time completed between each assessment.

- It is *highly* encouraged to retake the assessment at least one more time.
- You have up to **five** attempts on the Placement Assessment.
- Before retaking the assessment however, you will need to practice your learning modules.
- To access your modules for the first time, you will need to log back in to your ALEKS account as if you were going to take the test again.
- After you log in, select START MY PATH from the Primary Guidance Menu to start your module work. *Please note you will only be able to choose one of the offered paths*.
- Once you choose one, you will not be able to change it.
- In order to take the assessment again, you must have at least **3 hours of modules** completed.
- There is a cool-off period of 48 hours before you can access your next attempt.
- Keep in mind, the last day to take a placement assessment for Fall 2024 is on Aug. 9, 2024, at 11:59 pm CDT. Therefore, you would have needed to complete your previous Placement Assessment 48 hours before.
