## **Credit by Examination Information**

The University of the Incarnate Word awards credit based upon the concept that learning may be acquired from different sources of knowledge. For this reason, we recognize various examinations through which students may demonstrate their proficiency with the content tested. The following regulations/policies apply toward the awarding of credits based upon examination:

## **Credit by Examination Policy:**

- No more than 30 credit hours may be earned by examination or in combination with correspondence work.
- Credits granted through examination are considered transfer credit and may not fulfill residency requirements for any degree.
- An exam may be attempted only twice (see #4) with a mandatory six months waiting period between each attempt.
- The Computer Literacy exam may be attempted for credit or to demonstrate competence and <u>may be attempted once</u>. If taken for credit, a Challenge Exam form must be completed and a payment of 40% of the tuition is due in advance.
- Examination credit is posted as "S" on the transcript and will not count in the grade point average statistics.
- Credit will not be granted when the content of the exam duplicates credits previously attempted or awarded or when the student has credit for courses at a more advanced level that that of the exam.
- Credit through exam may not be earned once a student is in his/her final semester of enrollment.

## **Advanced Placement (AP)**

The Advanced Placement (AP) Program is sponsored by the College Board and offers secondary school students the opportunity to participate in challenging university-level course work with the potential of receiving university credit. UIW requires a minimum score of "3" for credit. Official score reports should be sent to the Registrar, who will evaluate the report and determine the amount of credit to be awarded. In most cases, the ACE recommendation will be used. However, AP tests are under constant evaluation and scores are subject to change according to the evaluation period.
